After obtaining a prescription from an eye care professional, prescription strength can be entered on the website which searches through a database for a pair of donated eyeglasses that fit the individual's needs. Small fee of \$6.99 for shipping and handling. Eyeglasses usually ship within 7-10 days of order.
