Services include early learning programs, counseling, youth programs, foster care, and adoption.

Provides short-term, emergency shelter for children, birth through age 12, whose families are faced with emergencies or who are in crisis, as a means of preventing child abuse and neglect. Families may bring their children for reasons including parental stress, parental or sibling illness or death; lack of utilities; food or shelter; domestic violence; etc. The average stay of a child is two to three days.

Services each child receives include 24-hour as well as medical and developmental assessments, therapeutic activities, any prescribed medication, and proper nutrition. Families receive parent education and follow-up services.

The Missouri Child Care Subsidy Program increases access to early learning by helping eligible families with the cost of child care. This allows families to focus on finding and holding steady jobs or to attend school and training programs. In order to qualify for child care assistance in Missouri, families must:

- Have a child birth to age 13, or a child with special needs or receiving protective services
- Need child care to work, search for work, participate in job training, or attend school
- Be at or below 150% of the federal poverty level
